



What's in a tooth?

- 1 **Crown** - The part of the tooth you can see. It is covered by enamel.
- 2 **Tooth Enamel** - The hardest material in your entire body. White shiny enamel protects the crown of the tooth.
- 3 **Dentin** - The main part of the tooth beneath the crown and root surface.
- 4 **Root** - The root anchors your tooth into the jawbone.
- 5 **Root Canal** - The open space inside the root where the pulp is found.
- 6 **Pulp** - The soft tissue containing the blood vessels and nerves that keep the tooth alive.
- 7 **Gum** - The soft pink tissue surrounding the teeth.
